All activities are supervised by our experienced instructors. How do our school programmes work?

1. You choose one of our school programmes lasting 3 hours or 5.5 hours.
2. Within our school programmes, you can choose what you want to do with your students*. To this end, we have developed activities in categories A, B and C.
3. The groups you have created will remain unchanged for the rest of the programme. This allows us to create the best group dynamics and really work on teamwork within the group!

What do we expect from the teachers?

Teachers can make an important contribution to the programme! Our starting point is collaboration between students, but also between students and teachers. Here are a few tips to make the day run as smoothly, enjoyably and safely as possible:

- Inform the students timely about the appropriate clothing. Ensure that they wear clothing that can get wet and dirty, including shoes, and bring a dry set!

Tip!
Wear sports clothing and shoes that can get wet and dirty and bring a dry set with you.

- Ensure that there are at least 1 and no more than 2 supervisors per group.
- Let the students come up with the solutions themselves as much as possible, but make an active contribution during the activities.
- Together with the instructors, ensure that the agreed safety rules are observed.

School programmes

You may choose from the following two school programmes:

School programme 3 hours at 22 per person**

You may choose 3 activities, at least 1 of which must be from category C.

School programme 5.5 hours at 32 per person**

You may select 5 activities, at least 1 of which must be from category C. This programme includes a 30-minute break. Refreshments are not included, but can be provided.

You will find explanations of the various activities on the following pages. The above school programmes can be booked for children aged 8 and above.

Rope course survival

Discover what the group is capable of on a low ropes course. This activity is both physically challenging and focused on teamwork. Will the group get everyone to the other side?

Crate stacking

A real team activity at great heights! Every student in the class is important! The climber stacks the tower and tries to maintain balance for as long as possible, while the other classmates throw the crates to the climber. How high will the tower get? That depends on the teamwork and the size of the group! Students who are afraid of heights can set their own limits with this activity, making it perfect for everyone!

Wall climbing

Conquer the challenging climbing walls of our climbing tower! The students climb to the top and can support and help each other from the ground. Which group will manage to reach the top? Students who are afraid of heights can also set their own limits in this activity.

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Category B Teamwork under the guidance of an instructor



Raft building

The whole group together on one raft... will that work out?! With the class (or part of the class), the students build the strongest raft possible, and then launch it into the water. The groups are given a knot chart to figure out the different knots themselves. Having trouble? No worries! Our instructor is on hand to provide some extra explanation. Please note: a swimming certificate is required for raft building.

Archery tag

Archery tag can best be described as a combination of dodgeball, paintball and archery. With your own bow and some arrows (with soft tips), everyone runs onto the field and tries to shoot the others. Are the arrows gone? Then it is time to search the large field! The group competes against each other in two teams in various game formats. Of course, there is an explanation first so that everyone can shoot with a bow and arrow. To protect the face, we use archery tag masks. Action and excitement are guaranteed in this activity!

Team activities

Team activities are the ideal way to promote teamwork and discover each other's strengths. During this activity, students are presented with team games that they can only solve together. On average, three games are played per hour, but this number may vary depending on how well the students are doing.

Clog golf

Clog golf is an accessible, sometimes hilarious activity. The class is divided into smaller groups and each group is given a stick with a clog attached to it. Using a ball, the group must reach the new "hole" in as few strokes as possible. Along the way, they may be watched by a few friendly sheep.

Disc golf

Disc golf is another variation of golf. As with clog golf, the class is divided into smaller groups and they work together within those groups. The goal? To throw the disc (Frisbee) into the basket in as few throws as possible. Be warned, this can be more difficult than you might think!

XXL games

All the popular family games, but on a grand scale! Jenga with blocks as big as bricks, Mikado with sticks as big as broomsticks – in short, everything in an XXL version. The games are all laid out together, including brief instructions. The class plays in smaller groups against their classmates. Who can keep the Jenga tower standing the longest? And which group is best at Twister?
